

## WEEKLY HEADLINES

-the NFPD is warning residents to watch out for a black car with flashing red, white and blue lights who appears to be impersonating police and trying to pull people over in the area. If you question whether someone pulling you over is legitimate, call 911.

-Holly Rose Gillenwater, 28, of the Town of Niagara, was arrested and charged with DWI and Endangering the Welfare of a Child after being pulled over on River Road by a Niagara County Sheriff early Tuesday morning. She was intoxicated and had a young child in the car.

-bullets were flying late Monday afternoon in an alley between Willow and Pierce Avenue. According to reports, the shooter was chasing a younger male down an alley and shot five times at him. The shooter fled the scene and the victim was not struck.

-the Niagara County Sheriff's Office is asking for public help in locating Kenneth Arthur Williams III, a Level 2 Sex Offender, who had an active arrest warrant for violating NYS Registry Laws out of the City of Niagara Falls. Contact 911 with any information.

-Niagara Falls Police responded to calls of shots fired around the area of 17th and Pierce Avenue on August 22nd. No injuries were reported at this time. This is at least the third response for a shooting in the past week.

-Niagara Falls Police & Fire responded to the 1800 block of Willow Avenue on Thursday August 23rd for a stabbing. The victim was stabbed in the neck and transported to ECMC. The suspect was detained on scene and will be charged / arraigned this morning.

-Thaddeus Pryor, 18, was charged with reckless endangerment & resisting arrest for an incident involving a gun being discharged near Hometown Grocery. Police found the getaway vehicle on 70th St. as well as a handgun inside the home & 5 marijuana plants in the backyard.

-a true Cinderella story unfolded this morning during a foot chase between Niagara Falls Police and a criminal suspect as he lost a shoe on 69th Street.

-after responding to a call for an abandoned vehicle with two flat tires on 72nd Street in Niagara Falls on Friday afternoon, police approached the owner's home which was nearby. Upon arrival, police noticed multiple potted plants of marijuana on the porch.

-police responded to a shooting leaving two injured. The shooting is believed to have happened at Poppy's Place on Cayuga Drive. Available information indicates one victim was shot in the head and the other in the chest. Both are at ECMC.

-Justin Gabby, 30, was arrested outside the McDonalds on Pine Avenue for what police described as "aggressive panhandling." According to patrons of the restaurant, Gabby was going up to windows of cars in the drive thru begging for money or food.

Niagara Falls Police are investigating a shooting after two people were shot late Sunday / early Monday morning.

## Restaurant Review: Lin BBQ & Grill

Lin BBQ & Grill, located at 485 Oliver Street in North Tonawanda, is an excellent choice for Chinese food in the area.

I was told to try it from one of my friends at Kelly's Corner in Niagara Falls and I am so glad I did!

There is no place around like Lin BBQ. What makes this place so unique is you get served with real plates and serving dishes. This may seem like a general statement, but even the food is fresh (which let's be honest doesn't always seem the case when we go out nowadays).

Each dish and sauce is distinctly different. It is NOTHING like your normal Asian takeout where everything tastes and looks the same and served on Styrofoam or paper.

We started out with huge bowls of delicious wonton soup which consisted of minced pork wrapped in wontons piping hot with a rich chicken broth. It took a long time to finish this but it was so good I finished the whole bowl (and I'm not just saying that).

After the soup came cheese wontons that you can tell were super fresh and filled with seasoned cream cheese.

Then came the grilled lamb, chicken and shrimp kabobs that were fall-off-the-stick tender and flavorful (like super flavorful). We had the General Tso's Chicken, honey chicken, chicken lo mein, house fried rice with shrimp, chicken, beef and BBQ spare ribs.

The presentation was honestly the best I have ever seen for this kind of food. The service was spot on and it was honestly the best Chinese food I have had on this side of the Canadian border.

The restaurant offers dine in or take out. You REALLY need to try this place. Don't forget to tell them Jamie sent you!!

next highest fringe minority rating would be the odds-on favorite, Public Advocate Letitia James, an African-American woman. Unlike it was with the then Chicago community organizer Barack Obama, in NYC the Public Advocate is an actual position that is first in-line to replace an incapacitated (or indicted) mayor. James actually replaced NYC Mayor Bill de Blasio on the job, himself with the fringe credentials of being in an inter-racial marriage. Like de Blasio, the Brooklyn-born James was elected at large, and was the first African-American woman in NYC's history to have been so. But, unlike de Blasio, I could find nothing about her having a spouse.

James is also endorsed by both de Blasio and by Governor Andrew Cuomo, two men who are often bitterly at odds with each other. The endorsements might be a strategic one, though. With James' popularity, an AG win might keep her out of the way for a run at either the mayor's or the governor's office.

The beautiful Buffalo-born Leecia Eve has the 3rd-best fringe minority ratings. As an African-American woman, she is the very bright daughter of former Buffalo Deputy Assembly Speaker Arthur Eve. Her resume is impressive, but her being from upstate NY won't be working in her favor, especially in the field of candidates that she faces for a statewide office. Like James, I also found no mention of she having spouse.

That brings us to the married white woman, Zephyr Teachout. Her spouse is a white man. Imagine that! Nonetheless,

she has some very impressive political accomplishments herself. As Cuomo's opponent in the last Democratic gubernatorial primary, the law professor gained 34% of the vote – not bad. The most notable endorsement that she has received thus far may have been from Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez, a 29-year old Puerto Rican who's running in the Democratic primary in New York's 14th congressional district that serves parts of Bronx and Queens counties in New York City.

I have found nothing of Teachout's religion that will bolster her fringe minority ratings, but a plus is that when she ran against Cuomo her running mate was an Asian man named Tim Wu. It should be noted that former Assembly Speaker Sheldon Silver came out against her stance on Israel during her run against Cuomo.

But I have to say it – what would a stance on Israel, pro or con, have

anything to do with being an effective governor, attorney general or assembly speaker of any state. Back then, wasn't that Hillary Clinton's and President Obama's job?

In fact, what would any of the fringe minority ratings have to do with any voter voting for any of the above jobs as well?

But this is New York State. To a lot of the voters, those things matter far more than a person's actual ability to do those jobs; even more so than a candidates knowledge of what the job is supposed to be.

In fact, each of the candidates spoke of fighting against President Trump when and if they get into office. Ironically, when WGRZ's Claudia Ewing asked the Buffalo-born Keith Wofford -- the lone black Republican male that is running unopposed for AG -- what he thought about the Trump Administration, he had

the best answer of all.

"The voters of New York, regardless of who the president is," said Wofford, "needs an attorney general who will make sure that billions of dollars are not disappearing. And that's something that is independent of who the president it. Frankly, the over-politicization of the attorney general's office is one of the things that is hurting us." And it all makes me wonder about the voters of the state that I love.

By the way, Wofford's fringe minority ratings, not only is he African-American, he's married to a white woman. In the general election, will white male and conservative female Democratic voters cross lines to vote for him? We'll see.

tion were passionate about restoring and sustaining the NT Botanical Garden worthy of the pride we once had in it.

As with any project as large as this there were bound to be challenges. Two of the challenges we faced right off the bat were funding and bodies to facilitate our vision.

The committee progressed quickly over a short time; facilitated by community volunteers on scheduled

workdays. Randy Bradt of the Niagara County Legislature procured funds from casino fund revenue for the City of North Tonawanda to use to help this project.

I requested that those funds be used to replace the garden's centerpiece - a gazebo that had become unsafe over time - that ultimately was installed in August of 2016. Soon thereafter, funds became available for a kayak launch which was installed later that same year.

This grass roots group has now become the North Tonawanda Botanical Garden Organization (NTBGO); a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. Legislator Randy Bradt played a key role in this transition and this organization was officially incorporated on June 14, 2018.

The NTBGO achieved tax-exempt status on July 23, 2018, which allows for applications for available grant funding. In fact, more than three applications have already been submitted for three grants.

The NTBGO has even partnered with other local nonprofit groups. For instance, NTBGO supplies plants for Project Pride's planters and is work-

ing with Buffalo Niagara Waterkeeper on educational programs and tree breeding.

A greenhouse was put to use last winter for growing hundreds of annuals and perennials that have been planted in the botanical garden and around the city.

Many of the botanical garden's flowerbeds have already been transformed. The old fountain area is now a butterfly garden designed to attract pollinators such as birds, bees, and butterflies. Three low-lying areas that collect storm water in spring and fall months have been turned into rain gardens with plants that thrive in wet conditions and also attract pollinators.

Many future plans such as plant sales to residents and instructional garden events are also taking shape.

The NTBGO has an active membership. Its Executive Committee members are Chairman David Conti, Vice Chair Mathew Wolcott, Secretary Laura Pecoraro, and Treasurer Amanda Reimer. Many other members share their gardening and plant expertise; Sherrie Mitchell, Coleen Erick, James Moll, Bruce Herman, and Lauren Tandy are the core group.

Quarterly meetings are held in February, May, and August at the NT Public Library; and meetings are open to the public. The annual meeting is held in November.

tive for the time that he served this country, but we are thankful for what he has added to our own community in North Tonawanda."



Labor Day is next Monday. For most, it marks the sad conclusion to our summer - the last chance to enjoy a final summer cookout, roller coaster ride or day at the beach. Political speeches have become an integral part of the holiday marking the time when much of the public usually starts to pay attention to the campaigns. But more importantly it is a time Americans think about the sacrifices unions have made, as it relates to wages and safety issues. This national holiday, celebrated every first Monday in September, arose as a tribute to the greatest of all things – the American worker. The first Labor Day holiday was celebrated on Tuesday, September 5, 1882, in New York City, in accordance with the plans of the Central Labor Union. In 1884 the first Monday in September was selected as the holiday, and the Central Labor Union urged similar organizations in other cities to follow the example of New York and celebrate a "workingmen's holiday" on that date. The idea spread with the growth of labor organizations, and in 1885 Labor Day was celebrated in many industrial centers of the country. Despite the celebrations every year, Labor Day actually ascended from a tragic conclusion to a labor strike. President Cleveland and Congress unanimously created the nationally recognized holiday in 1894 after intervening in the Pullman Strike that resulted in the death of numerous workers at the hands of the U.S. military and U.S. Marshals. Labor Day stands as a creation of the labor movement and is dedicated to the social and economic achievements of American workers. It constitutes a yearly national tribute to the contributions workers have made to the strength, prosperity, and well-being of our country. The vital force of labor added materially to the highest standard of living and the greatest production the world has ever known and has brought us closer to the realization of our traditional ideals of economic and political democracy. It is appropriate, therefore, that the nation pays tribute on Labor Day to the creator of so much of the nation's strength, freedom, and leadership — the American worker. Today, all U.S. states, the District of Columbia, and the territories have made it a statutory holiday.


