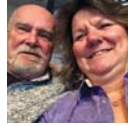


running the city into the ground."

Mike Shepard: "Mayor Dyster, I would like to take you on a tour of this city's streets. I'll drive. Your car. OK?"

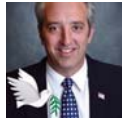


Donna Kraft Deters: "I live in the city! I have never witnessed a crime.. But then again. I don't go out after dark. I also don't hang around criminals."

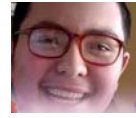

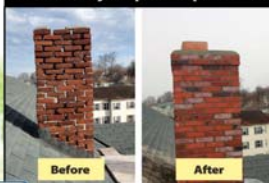

Shopping on Main Street for shoes at Howard's and the multiple buildings that Jens had for shopping, all with multiple floors of shopping.

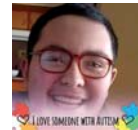
Main Street didn't die because of urban renewal though, it died because of the Summit Mall.

We can't recreate the old Falls Street.

The conference center and Sheridan are in the way of that happening, and the best we could hope for at this point would be shops that could be a mixture of tourist ones mixed in with year round places of business that would be popular with locals as well as tourists.

Still waiting to see the big investments that NFR will be making.

Dan Baldwin: "What a shame, corruption and wanna be Politicians lining their own pockets led to the downward spiral of Niagara Falls.

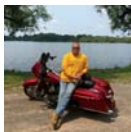

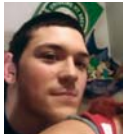



Restaurant Review: Harris Restaurant & Catering

“Harris Restaurant and Catering” is located at 630 10th street right across from Memorial hospital. Did you know it was there? I didn't, but now couldn't be happier to have stumbled upon this hidden Niagara Falls gem.

When I walked in with my daughter we were greeted by a husband and wife duo that sat us down and just started serving us food. They went above and beyond, and not just with the food, but with their hospitality as well.

I made the mistake of asking what they suggested to try, and from then on the plates just kept coming out one by one.

First we were served steak and cheese fries, which were crinkle cut and topped with steak, green peppers, onions, mozzarella cheese and a savory blend of seasonings.

Next we were served fish bits (and that's exactly what they were!). Bite sized pieces of haddock with a perfectly seasoned corn meal flour mix on all four sides. I literally heard a crunch each bite.

Round three was a platter with their famous “soul burger” sliders. Home-made chicken fingers, bbq chicken and asiago cheese slider. Wow!! The soul burger was out of this world. The beef



was seasoned and had specks of green peppers topped with American cheese on a buttered grilled roll.

I asked why they call it a “soul burger” and was told because it has “flavor!!” And boy was he right!!

Now I must say, chicken fingers normally do nothing for me and I never order them, but there was something about these that made me want more. They are homemade with a lightly seasoned thin and crispy crust (super good).

The bbq chicken slider was moist, tender and the combination of the chicken, cheese, the bbq sauce made this sandwich complete.

At this point I thought we were done, which would have been totally fine because we were stuffed! As it turned out though, we weren't done yet.

Up next, a fall off the bone bbq turkey rib. Yes, turkey rib (I never had a turkey rib).

Then out came chicken and shrimp Alfredo. This was phenomenal!

The Alfredo sauce was creamy just the right amount of spices to make it have a unique delicious flavor. Both the chicken & shrimp combination was so good.

The next plate had a pork rib, baked beans and yummy homemade mac & cheese. The rib was to die for and the beans had so many flavors with onions, peppers and ground turkey, and the macaroni and cheese did us good.

Just as we were ready to roll out of there, the owners came out with smirks on their faces and bombarded us with desserts. Banana pudding with chunks of bananas (by far my favorite) and chocolate cake topped with vanilla mousse (I felt like I died and went to heaven).

We also sampled a trio of cheese-

OSHA 10 & 30-Hour Courses Changed to Meet Safety Objectives

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration's (OSHA) 10 and 30-hour courses provide information needed to help frontline workers, as well as foremen and supervisors, be more aware of health and safety hazards they may face and how they can be avoided. After receiving feedback that trainers were unable to cover the necessary job-specific hazards workers may face within the courses' time limits, OSHA decided to change some of the required teaching elements. The agency released new Outreach Training Program requirements on January 1, 2018 that went into effect on April 1, 2018. The highlights of those changes include:

- The Introduction to OSHA portion of the courses is now only required to last one hour instead of two.
- The optional topics for Construction and General Industry courses increased by one hour for both the 10 and 30-hour courses.
- Fall Protection is now required to last 90 minutes instead of 75 minutes in construction courses.

OSHA standards for construction have numerous training and safety requirements. Many of these standards specifically require employers to train workers on the hazards they may come in contact with, including job-specific safety concerns, general safety and health provisions and the need for personal protective equipment and fall protection. To help employers and workers meet these training requirements, OSHA created the Outreach Training Program, which was developed to improve workplace safety and health by providing access to OSHA-authorized trainers. Some employers, unions, and organizations require OSHA 10 and/or 30-hour training before workers ever step foot on a jobsite. State and federal regulators want to ensure that workers who need OSHA training get OSHA training. These regulators want to establish a baseline of safety training for workers before they reach the jobsite. OSHA-authorized training is an effective and reliable way to inform workers of the most prevalent hazards on construction jobsites.

Workers who go through outreach training are issued an official Department of Labor OSHA card, commonly referred to as an OSHA-10 or OSHA-30 card. Ten-hour training is highly recommended for all construction workers and 30-hour training is the recommended minimum for any construction employee with supervisory or safety-related responsibilities. Although Outreach Training courses are an excellent way to create a solid baseline of safety training, these courses alone do not fulfill the training requirements found in many OSHA standards. Employers are responsible for providing additional training based on the specific hazards workers may encounter on the job, such as the additional training requirements found in OSHA's silica standard. Because of this, many construction companies consider OSHA 10 and 30-hour training as only one essential part of their safety program.

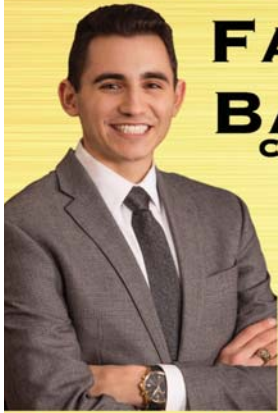
